## THE OPENING DRIVE

TONIGHT IS THE 58TH ALL TIME MEETING BETWEEN THE SOLON COMETS AND THE TWINSBURG TIGERS  
Solon leads the all time series with Twinsburg 46-8-3

Twinsburg started the season with a 49-point outburst vs. Copley in a Week 1 win led by QB Adam Van de Motter's big night with 5 total touchdowns.

Week 2 will be a much different challenge as the Tigers travel to Solon to take on a Comets team coming off a 25-0 win over Aurora.

The Comets accumulated 243 yards on the ground and held the Greenmen to 87 total yards in the Week 1 win.

The Comets' run game was anchored by sophomore running back Khalil Eichelberger, who ran for 138 yards and three touchdowns on 25 carries.

Aurora was held to seven yards in the first half and finished the game with minus-5 rushing yards thanks in part to Solon senior defensive lineman Nate Leskovec.

The Comets defense shined brightest in the fourth quarter, as they were able to stop the Greenmen not once, but twice on fourth down at the Solon 1.

Van de Motter led the way for Twinsburg in the 49-28 win over visiting Copley, completing 17 of 27 passes with 5 TDs and 499 total yards of offense. Dominick Glenn, Jameel Banks and James Bessett all had over 100 yards receiving.

Defensively, Rashad Jones-Land and Aidan Malenchek had solid games vs. Copley and will be counted on to slow down Eichelberger and the Solon ground attack.

They are coming off an impressive win against a great program in Aurora and I'm sure they are flying high. We must build on the momentum we established in our opener and allow it to carry over into our preparation this week. We will be challenged in different ways this week and I'm excited to see how we respond."

Twinsburg senior quarterback Adam Van de Motter was given the sole control of the offense in 2018 after splitting time at the position the last few years.

Van de Motter wasted no time taking advantage of the role, running up 499 yards of total offense and accounting for five total touchdowns in leading the Tigers to a 49-28 win over Copley in Week 1.

Van de Motter hooked up with Dominick Glenn (5 catches, 163 yards) for touchdowns twice in the first quarter to put Twinsburg in the early lead.

The Indians were able to catch the Tigers at 21 to tie the score at halftime.

In the second half, Van de Motter threw two more touchdowns, and Jamir James and Phillip Wallace scored on the ground to put the victory away.

Jameel Banks caught a pair of TDs and finished with 124 yards receiving. James Besett also went over 100 yards receiving for Twinsburg.

The Tigers had over 600 yards of offense.

#### WEEK 1 RECAP - SOLON SHUTSOUT AURORA

The Solon Comets took full advantage of their first opportunity on the 2018 schedule with a 25-0 win over Aurora at Veterans Stadium last Friday night.

Solon's scoring began after the midpoint of the first quarter with Harrison Rich connecting on a 24-yard field goal.

Not long after, sophomore tailback Khalil Eichelberger went two yards into the end zone. The two-point conversion play was successful with Pat McQuaide completing a three yard pass to Najee Story.

Both the second and third quarters saw Khalil Eichelberger with touchdown runs and Harrison Rich with successful extra point attempts.

The Comets' offensive effort featured Quarterback Jimmy Casamento completing six passes for 36 yards and Quarterback Pat McQuaide connecting through the air five times for 67 yards.

Defensively for Solon, Jeff Barnett led the way with 10 tackles, of which five were tackles for loss.

Solon gave up only five yards to the Aurora offense after the first 24 minutes of play and kept Aurora under 100 total yards for the entire game.

## HEAD COACH MIKE BELL

Hired February 4, 2015

Mike Bell is in his fourth year as coach of the Tigers and is looking to build on his past successes, bringing winning football back to Twinsburg.

Prior to coming to Twinsburg, Bell served one year as the head coach at Eastlake North and had a very successful 12-year run as head coach at Lake Catholic in Mentor.

In 12 seasons at Lake Catholic, the Cougars won 6 NCL Championships, qualified for the state playoffs 8 times (playoff record of 17-8) with 5 Regional Title appearances (2003, 2006, 2007, 2009, 2010) and 3 state semifinal appearances (2007, 2009, and 2010).

Prior to 2002, Bell served as the Cougars' defensive coordinator for three seasons, winning the Division III State Championship in 2001.

Prior to coaching at Lake Catholic, Bell spent three years at Willoughby South as a position coach and defensive coordinator, four years at Maple Heights, and two seasons at his alma mater Pymatuning Valley.

## GRIDIRON CLUB

Twinsburg coach Mike Bell has always been a strong believer in building a program and not just simply a football team that competes on Friday night.

Part of that is the involvement of those outside of the players and coaches, including the administration, the community and perhaps most importantly, the football parents.

Bell said the Tigers are extremely lucky to have the support of The Gridiron Club at Twinsburg and he doesn't take it for granted.

"It starts with our administration doing a great job getting our young men the equipment and necessities for the game, but when you think about all the extras to make us a first-class program that is where the Gridiron Club comes in and really help us," Bell said.

"There are a million ways for parents to get involved and I always encourage parents to get involved and do what they can because it doesn't last forever at the high school level obviously. The years go fast."

The Gridiron Club is an organization of football parents in grades 7 through 12. There is no fee to join and all members of the community are welcome to attend meetings. The Club meets the second Monday of the month at Twinsburg High School. Meetings begin at 6:00 p.m. All of the fundraising is run through Twinsburg Athletic Boosters.

The Gridiron Club raises funds to help support the team off the turf. From purchasing a new sound system for the locker room to feeding the boys on Friday nights and scrimmages, purchasing football gear such as t-shirts and cinch bags, senior gifts and hosting the end of year

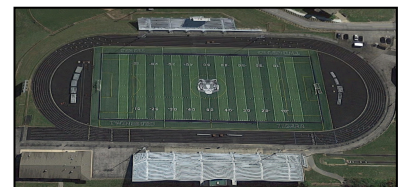

Twinsburg Tiger Stadium is one of the most used athletic facilities in Northeast Ohio. Twinsburg officials say Tiger Stadium's field gets used upwards of 950 times each year for various athletic events and practices -- from football, to soccer, to Relay For Life, to regional sporting events.

In the summer of 2015, the Stadium received a major upgrade to the playing surface. New field turf was installed featuring a unique blue border and a large Tiger logo at midfield. The 'grass' has a "paneled" look of lighter and darker green shades every five yards replacing a the carpet that was installed in 2005.

Tiger Stadium has become a perennial site for OHSAA football playoff games, hosting two games last year - the Division I Region 1 Semifinal (St Edward vs Stow) and the Division II Region 5 Final (Hudson and Warren Harding)

## THIS DATE IN HISTORY

**August 31, 1895** The first professional football game is played at Latrobe, Pa. between Latrobe, Pa YMCA and Jeannette Athletic Club. Latrobe YMCA pays \$10 to quarterback John Brallier for expenses. LaTrobe YMCA beats the Jeannette Athletic Club 12-0.

**August 31, 1990** Ken Griffey Jr. and Sr. became the first father-son teammates in MLB history, when the two appear in a game for the Seattle Mariners against the Kansas City Royals. Senior batted second in the lineup and Junior hit right behind him. Not only were they the first father-son team to ever be in the same lineup together, but they were the first father-son duo to be on the basepaths together as both singled off Storm Davis.

**August 31, 1993** Minnesota Twins beat Cleveland Indians 5-4 in 22 innings. Pedro Munoz led off the 22nd inning for the home team Twins, with a home run to end the game. Munoz's HR ended the 6-hour 17-minute contest, that saw Kenny Lofton go 1-9 with a BB, Carlos Baerga was 4-9 with a 2B and RBI, and Sandy Alomar was 0-8. Indians current pitching coach, Carl Willis, pitched an inning in relief for the Minnesota Twins.
