Draw your own National Park Landscape

Day 1 10 min	Art: Investigate and observe various famous national parks around the country.	Research national parks around the country and choose your favorite. Focus on why and how it is important.
Day2 10 min	Art: Understanding background, middleground, and foreground.	Watch example video (https://www.youtube.com/results?search_query=easy+middleground%2C+background%2C+foreground) and make 3 sketches practicing background, middleground, and foreground.
Day 3 10 min	Art: Applying knowledge of background, middleground, and foreground to create a final project.	Start your final landscape project inspired by your favorite national park on regular white 8x11" computer paper. Draw out the landscape with pencil including at least 4 objects from nature. Make sure to include background, middle ground, and foreground.
Day 4 10 min	Art: Experiment with various art media to inform art making.	Using art materials of your choice add color to your final landscape. No cheese holes or large areas of white space.
Day 5 10 min	Art: Understand and develop a written artist statement, reflecting on personal expression and concept.	Write an artist statement (2-3 sentences) on a separate piece of notebook paper discussing which national park your landscape is inspired from and why this national park is important.
