TB Kareem Hunt, Willoughby South: Junior tailback rushed for 2,289 yards on 251 carries (9.1-yard average) and 37 touchdowns, and caught two touchdown passes. He had single-game rushing totals of 485 yards (fifth-best in state history), 415, 310 and 308 yards.

DE Tom Strobel, Mentor: Michigan recruit was a constant pest to opposing offensive backfields as his 11 quarterback sacks and 33 pressures attest.

LBBen Gedeon, Hudson: Junior has developed into a major college prospect after totaling 95 tackles, including 5 for loss and 6 quarterback hurries.

LB Nick Davidson, Solon: Linebacker played much bigger than his 5-8, 190-pound frame. Mustered 113 tackles with 66 solos, 21 for loss and 2 interceptions.

LB Kurt Laseak, Mentor: Ohio recruit registered 100 tackles, including four for loss and two interceptions.

CB De'Van Bogard, Glenville: Ohio State recruit collected 91 tackles, 3 sacks, 2 forced fumbles, 7 pass breakups and 2 interceptions.

Co-offensive Players of the Year

QB Mitch Trubisky, Mentor: The 603, 195-pound junior quarterback passed for 3,845 yards and 41 touchdowns while also rushing for 611 yards and 12 TDs.

RB Jack Snowball, Wadsworth: The 6-0, 211-pound senior running back rushed for 2,594 yards and 31 touchdowns. Despite touching the ball about 350 times, he did not fumble once. He finished his career with 3,795 yards rushing.
