
Minutes of SPECIAL Meeting

February 27, 2013

The Twinsburg City School District Board of Education met in SPECIAL session on the above date at 7:00 p.m. at the Twinsburg RB Chamberlin Middle School Auditorium/Cafeteria, 10270 Ravenna Road, Twinsburg, Ohio 44087. Roll was called at 7:02 and the following board members were present: Mrs. Cain-Criswell, Mr. Crosby, and Mr. Stuver. Mr. Andrews and Mr. Shebeck were not present.

The meeting was convened to give a presentation and have a discussion regarding the Governor's Proposed School Funding spreadsheet. The Governor's Proposed School Funding spreadsheets were released through the media and were not accompanied by any guidance or explanatory documentation. The released spreadsheets seem to contradict the governor's statements and are creating concern for many school districts around the state. In the Governor's proposal, Twinsburg School District, considered to be a wealthy district, may receive an increase of \$2.8 million while many low wealth districts will not receive any increase in funding.

On January 31, 2013 the governor told an audience of school superintendents and officials at a suburban Columbus hotel that the state will provide increased funding for poorer school districts statewide through a new formula that takes into account property values and income levels.

He added later, "If you are poor, you're going to get more. If you are richer, you're going to get less. ... If you have disabled students, you're going to get help. If you have gifted students, you're going to get help."
