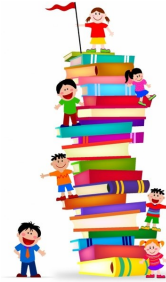
## ▶ Program Information

- The program uses non-fiction based materials.
- Intensive reading program staffed by experienced certified teachers and instructional assistants.
- Will work on vocabulary, comprehension and fluency skills.
- Homework Monday - Thursday to reinforce skills.
- Each day the students will spend time in our computer lab practicing reading and computer skills.
- Student may count 30 minutes a day towards required summer reading log.
- **Program runs from 9 to 11 am Monday to Friday, July 23rd to August 10th.**
- Please send 2 pencils and a folder, which will go back and forth each day to organize papers and homework.
- Send a **healthy** snack for your child, if desired.



## Twinsburg Public Library

- Each grade will go on a specified day each week. Example: K on Monday, 1<sup>st</sup> Tuesday etc...
- Students will still come to Dodge and then take a bus to the library after attendance.
- Students will be participating in the library's Summer Reading Program.
- Lessons will focus on learning to use the library, and children will be able to take books out each week.
- If student has a library card that has been lost, please send \$1 for a replacement card.



## Transportation
