THS Class of 2017

heads toward the future ready to impact positive change

The 303 members of the Twinsburg High School Class of 2017 celebrated their collective accomplishments during Commencement held at E.J. Thomas Performing Arts Hall in Akron on Tuesday, May 23rd. Family members, friends, fellow students and staff joined the graduates in their honor to mark the significance of the exciting occasion. Twinsburg High School’s graduation ceremony is a time-honored annual ritual that follows the protocol of practices from years past, while also paying special tribute to the exceptional and unique achievements of this year’s senior class.

The commencement ceremony began with the THS Class of 2017 Top Ten Students taking their seats on the stage, which was adorned with beautiful greenery. Joining the students were members of the Twinsburg Board of Education, District Administration, Twinsburg High School Principal and Assistant Principals, High School Guidance Department Staff, and Building Principals and Assistant Principals from Wilcox Primary School, Samuel Bissell Elementary School, George G. Dodge Intermediate School, and R.B. Chamberlin Middle School.

The Twinsburg High School Concert Band, under the direction of Mr. Ryan Bonitz, struck up the traditional processional of *Pomp and Circumstance*, No. 1, by Elgar while the graduates entered E.J. Thomas Hall.

THS Senior Class Vice-President Victoria Leigh Henkel welcomed all in attendance and requested all share in a moment of silence for those who couldn’t attend the evening’s ceremony, remembering loved ones and friends. The band then performed *The Star-Spangled Banner*, by Francis Scott Key.

Asia Wilson, THS Senior Class Treasurer, introduced honored guests and asked all teachers in attendance to stand for special recognition. In continuing her welcome, Asia introduced member of the Twinsburg Board of Education, Central Office Administration, THS Principals, THS Assistant Principals, THS Guidance Counselors, and administrators from other District schools.

... THS Class of 2017 heads toward the future ready to impact positive change

The celebration carried on as the graduates and their guests were treated to two outstanding performances by four members of the Class of 2017 with songs marking the significance of the evening. Laura Karlson sang, *I'll Always Remember You*, by Andrew Green and Marie Brown-Gallenberg which was the namesake song of an episode of one of Disney's long-time series on its television network. Brooke Bartolovich, Victoria Henkel and Jennifer Noga then performed *Landslide*, written by Stevie Nicks. The lyrics were about the fear of change and conquering obstacles through moving words such as, "But time makes you bolder, even children get older, and I'm getting older too."

Fittingly, Superintendent Kathryn Powers delivered a speech centered on the Class of 2017's ability to impact positive change. "You have learned important life skills about the need to recognize and to celebrate the differences in each other and to have empathy for others who may be different than you in appearance, ability, socio-economic status and/or religious beliefs. You have learned the importance of resolving differences in amicable ways and the importance of collaboration, communication and camaraderie. Class of 2017, I believe that you are able... to be change agents by understanding those with differences of opinions and celebrating their unique perspectives while working together to make positive change happen!"

Powers encouraged the graduates to continue to be bold, saying she had the utmost confidence in their diverse goals and big dreams. The Superintendent stated that she was certain they would

achieve what they set out to do as stated in scholarship applications: whether in strategic communications in an effort to better share important information or in the field of computer science after earning a degree from an Ivy League school, or whether in a career as a psychologist or a doctor with a mission to design programs that promote healthy living.

Powers concluded her inspiring graduation message with "Live well, Class of 2017! Be the positive change agents our world needs. And, remember, once a Tiger always a Tiger!"

After the Superintendent's remarks, the "Top Ten Students" were introduced by Michael Silverthorn, Twinsburg High School Assistant Principal. The students were recognized for their exemplary academic accomplishments, extra-curricular activities, athletic achievements, community involvement, special areas of interest, and the college or university which they would be attending.

Andrew Yates was recognized as the THS Class of 2017 Valedictorian and acknowledged for his outstanding academic performance. Andrew has decided to continue his studies at The Ohio State University.

THS Class Secretary Prit Patel shared special recognition, national awards, and noted the over 31,138 hours of community service provided by the Class of 2017, including 4,109 hours completed by one student alone.

Twinsburg High School Principal Louise Teringo took the stage and drew connections to R&B star R. Kelly's song, *World's Greatest*, which he wrote as the theme to the movie "Ali," a film about the legendary boxer Muhammad Ali. Similar to *Landslide*, it's about

making heroic accomplishments after being boxed into a corner or pushed up against the proverbial ropes. She made references to specific student individual accomplishments then highlighted amazing collective feats, such as the Girls' Cross Country Team reaching States with a historic qualifying time (all the while supporting their coach who triumphed over cancer) and the Lady Bowlers qualifying for the first time in the school's history last year with present 2017 Seniors. Just like their counterparts on the fields and courts, she praised the Concert Band for scoring an overall Superior rating in its state competition.

Teringo challenged her students using one of Muhammad Ali's lesser known quotes: "He who is not courageous enough to take risks will accomplish nothing in life." She concluded with special recognition

for students who had perfect attendance all four years at THS and those staff members who were retiring after many years of service.

The attention then turned to the graduates proudly sitting in their caps and gowns, waiting to be announced as the newest alumni of Twinsburg High School. The crowd was eagerly ready for the certification and presentation of diplomas to the Class of 2017, symbolizing each student had met or exceeded the graduation requirements set forth by the State of Ohio and the Twinsburg Board of Education.

The diplomas were presented by Board President Mark Curtis, Vice President Matt Cellura and members Tina Davis, Robert Felber and Kathy Turle-Waldron. As the last graduate received her diploma, it was

now time for the "Turning of the Tassel Ceremony" led by 2017 Class President Brooke Bartolovich. Bartolovich reflected on how the graduates had all grown, how each had witnessed the transformation, and how they had impacted each other as they gained maturity. In closing, Brooke cited a favorite inspirational quote: "I close my eyes to old ends and open my heart to new beginnings."

As tassels were moved from right to left, the audience roared and the students were officially graduates of the Twinsburg City School District. The celebration concluded with the graduates leaving E. J. Thomas Hall into the embraces of friends and family as the celebratory sounds of the band playing *Fanfare and Recessional*, arr. James D. Ployhar, filled the arena.
