THS Class of 2020 triumphs over adversity

This wasn't how senior year was supposed to end for the Class of 2020. Yet despite this challenging moment in world history which resulted in the school year to be finished from home, the seniors in the Class of 2020 were celebrated for their accomplishments in unique ways that they will likely never forget.

While families are used to honoring their graduates at our traditional graduation ceremony, this year, Twinsburg High School celebrated the members of its 2020 class with multiple activities planned for the month of May culminating in a special parade throughout the community and the premiere of a Virtual Commencement Ceremony shown at the Midway Drive-In Theater.

The milestone of one's senior graduation is one of life's most universal human experiences. Recognizing what was taken away from the Twinsburg graduating class due to the coronavirus pandemic led to a bevy of additional opportunities to make each senior feel special.

To help members of the Class of 2020, their families, and the staff of Twinsburg City School District remain safe and socially distant, the seniors were invited to wear their caps and gowns to Tiger Stadium for an individual "Graduation Walk" on May 4 and 5 and was professionally filmed and photographed for the virtual ceremony. Twinsburg High School Assistant Principal Alex Popovich announced each graduate's name, where no more than 10 people were allowed at one time. Masks were worn and six feet of social distancing was maintained for each member of the Class of 2020. Families were encouraged to stay in their vehicles while filming took place, many taking their own photos from a distance. Included in each diploma cover were personalized letters of congratulations and support which had been written by parents and other members of our school community.

Seniors were able to don their prom attire during the "All Dressed Up With No Place To Go" event. Venditti Studio photographed the seniors in their prom attire on May 7. The Twinsburg Athletic Boosters donated a "Congratulations, Seniors!" banner that was displayed on the front lawn outside of the high school. The sign featured many of the graduates' senior class photos.

Another special moment took place on May 13 when members of the Twinsburg Board of Education, Twinsburg High School staff, Twinsburg Superintendent Kathi Powers and Business Manager Chad Welker boarded buses donned with congratulatory banners and set out on bus routes to place a sign in every graduate's yard. The traditional Senior Awards still took place, though virtually, on May 14, while spring senior athletes had their portraits taken professionally on May 17. A 2020 THS Virtual Athletic Signing video and a "Class of 2020... our Future is Bright" video were posted on the District website for everyone's enjoyment on May 31.

The celebration culminated on May 31, first with an incredible community-wide celebration during the first-ever 2020 THS Senior Parade. The parade, which included a police and fire escort, allowed the Twinsburg High School graduating class to safely travel through the city of Twinsburg, Twinsburg Township, and the village of Remindersville receiving cheers of congratulations from families and residents along the way.

Finally, seniors were formally honored at the Midway Drive-In Theater during the debut presentation of the virtual Commencement Ceremony celebrating the Class of 2020.

During the video, Twinsburg High School celebrated the 326 members of its 2020 graduating class recognizing the graduates' significant accomplishments, which included 65 Summa Cum Laude graduates, 19 Magna Cum Laude, and 33 Cum Laude graduates, respectively.

THS Senior Class Vice-President Samantha Gunn welcomed all in attendance. She asked the audience for a moment of silence and reflection to remember those who could not with them. Brendan Strok, THS Senior Class Treasurer, introduced honored guests, including Board of Education members.

Following introductions, a series of seniors delivered emotional performances. Rebecca Mold, Kevin Onion, Joshua Powell, and Emma Unangst played as an orchestra quartet delivering a performance of "American String Quartet in F Major, Op. 96, No. 12". Kiara Durbin, Sydney Goldstein, Mallory Mentzer, Olivia Sharp, and Regan Utrup sang, "Seasons of Love".

Herman "Trey" Durr III delivered a speech to the Class of 2020 called "Don't Be Afraid of Alliteration", which included special thanks to the teachers and staff members who went above and beyond, as well as thanks to the parents and families of the seniors. Durr, who noted that he had wanted to speak at graduation for as long as he could remember, shared the contents of notes he captured in his phone, which led to the title of his speech.

"When I was going through my notes to compose this speech I found a lot of weird ones," said Durr. "One quote read 'I'm not afraid of alliteration but some people are'. I'm going to miss having these funny moments with the people I love here at Twinsburg. And I hope nobody here is afraid of alliteration because the last thing I want to say is: Thank you Twinsburg for a Terrific Time."

Julian Tejada took to the stage next to perform, "In My Life," concluding the student-led performances of the ceremony.

Twinsburg City School District Superintendent Kathryn Powers addressed the graduates telling them they were no strangers to adversity. She noted that this class came into the world during the unprecedented and tragic time of post-9/11, which forced the country to adjust to a new way of life.

"You came into the world during a time of great change and uncertainty and today, our

world is once again changing, coming to terms with so many challenges caused by this pandemic. Through this experience, I have watched as you maneuvered through life's uncertainties, showing great character and resolve, and continuing to develop plans for your future," Powers said.

"With what you have experienced over the years, and especially now, you are experts in facing adversity. I am proud of your resilience, your dedication, your hard work, and your exceptional accomplishments."

In her remarks, Twinsburg High School Principal Dr. Laura Hebert shared how the Class of 2020 sacrificed much to end their time at the school yet how they triumphed despite a global pandemic.

"To be honest, I think the Class of 2020 has sacrificed more than any group affected by the pandemic. This year should represent a culmination of your athletic endeavors, your academic accomplishments, opportunities to perform on the stage, or as part of the orchestra, band and choirs, showcase your art and the announcement of your future plans and celebrations with family and friends as you take your next steps. Instead, you have

had to announce your college choice with chalk, pick up caps and gowns via a drive-through, sacrifice athletics altogether, and learn important academic concepts via Google classroom and Google Meet – not the easiest way to learn," Dr. Hebert offered in her speech.

She noted that from the day that the Twinsburg City School District announced the school would not re-open, the senior class had been strong, understanding, kind, compassionate and most importantly, had led the entire student body with love.

"You have completed classwork, attended meetings, thanked teachers, and carried on with such resiliency and strength that it has left me speechless – which, you know, is hard to do! What defines this class is a sense of a shared, common identity. Together, you triumphed," Dr. Herbert said.

Following the presentation of Krishna Patel as Salutatorian and Dominic Gordon as Valedictorian, respectively, THS Class Secretary Hannah Moeliono highlighted many of those exceptional accomplishments Superintendent Powers referred to in her speech.

Moeliono noted the numerous successes in academics, athletics, and the visual and performing arts. She also noted that the Class of 2020 gave back to the community through 27,217 hours of service. Senior Sahaj Bhabra accumulated nearly 1,015 hours herself. Finally, she highlighted that 109 members of the class would be receiving Honors Diplomas as determined by the state of Ohio.

Next, the roll call of the Class of 2020 to receive their diplomas was conducted by Alex Popovich, Twinsburg High School Assistant Principal as each graduate stepped forward, diploma covers in hand.

THS Class of 2020 Class President Kimberly Bajarias then led the class in the traditional "Turning of the Tassel Ceremony." The graduates, while not able to be seen as a collective group performing traditional movement of their tassels, each had the opportunity to do so from the safety of their cars, at the drive-in theater, while watching the Virtual Commencement Ceremony. While different, the sentiment of the moment remains, and it will certainly be a graduation the Class of 2020 and their families will never forget.



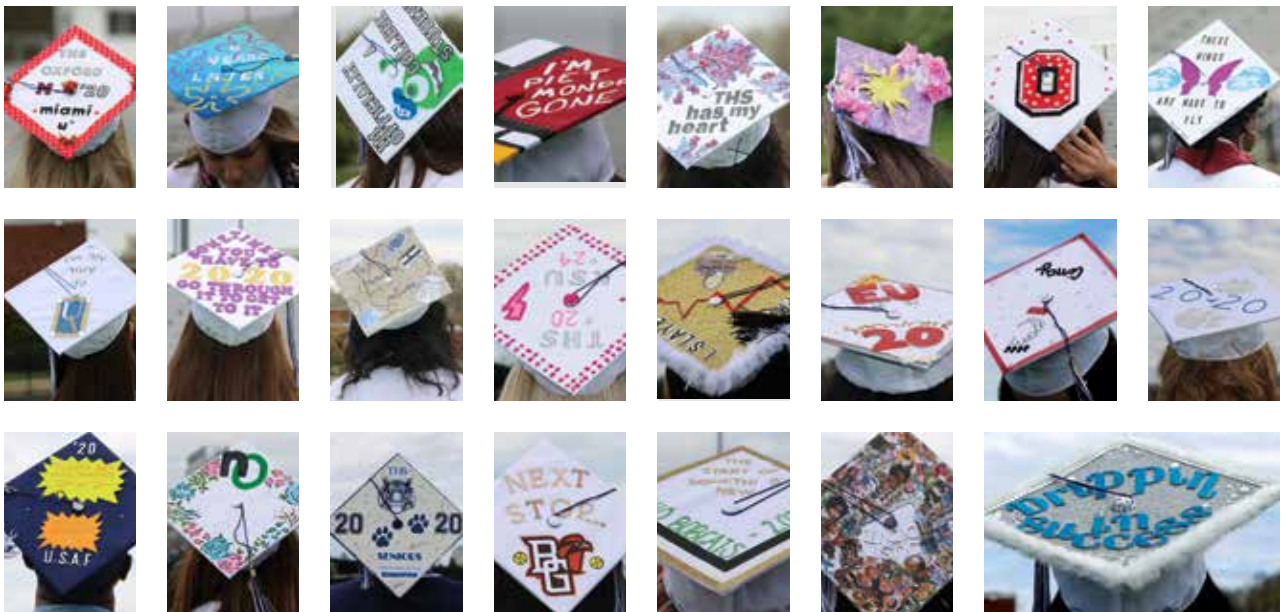
The shoes of the *Class of 2020*

Caps off to the Class of 2020!

For years, Twinsburg High School seniors have not been permitted to decorate their graduation caps, officially known as mortarboards. However, because of the sacrifices that were made by the Class of 2020, an exception was made this year. THS Seniors got creative and styled their mortarboards with special messages, artwork, and fun designs.



Did you know?

- The mortarboard cap, which pairs with standard graduation gowns, is believed to have been developed in the 15th century evolving from hats known as birettas used by Catholic clerics, scholars, and professors. The origin of the biretta dates back as far as 1311 in churches.
- The shape of the mortarboard may be symbolic. Many believe it signifies the form of a book to give a scholarly appearance or that it may be meant to represent the shape of a campus quad.
- The mortarboard borrows its name from the flat board used by bricklayers to lay mortar. Some believe the reason the cap is square as it represents the mortar board of a master workman.
- The cap and gown symbolize recognition and achievement.
- Until the 1950's, graduation caps and gowns were typically gray in America, but students became more interested in using different colors to represent their schools the way European countries had been doing since the 1800s.

Graduation wasn't the only tradition that shifted for the Class of 2020. For the seniors, their final prom was as well. Twinsburg High School wanted to ensure that the seniors had memories of their prom so they commissioned a photographer to capture the seniors in "All Dressed Up with No Place to Go" photos.
