**TWINS DAYS FESTIVAL COMMITTEE, INC./  
TWINSBURG CITY SCHOOL SYSTEM  
LEASE AGREEMENT #2009-007**

This Indenture of Lease made and entered into at Twinsburg, Ohio, by and between the **TWINSBURG CITY SCHOOL SYSTEM** (hereinafter "**Lessor**") and the **TWINS DAYS FESTIVAL COMMITTEE, INC.** (Hereinafter, "**Lessee**").

That for the term, and upon the terms, conditions and provisions hereinafter contained, **Lessor** does hereby let and lease unto **Lessee** the following described property, to sit: The R.B. Chamberlin Middle School property and the Dodge Intermediate School property. This shall include Twinsburg High School on Friday afternoon (For Field Games, and misc. activities) and evening (for Welcome Wiener Roast, and misc. activities), the Twinsburg High School for the use of their Parking Facilities for the weekend.

Said premises shall be used solely and exclusively for the purpose of celebrating the **TWINS DAYS FESTIVAL**.

**Lessee** shall have and hold said property for the term of three (3) days commencing on the 7th day of August and ending on the 9th day of August, 2009.


**Lessee** agrees to procure a Certificate of Insurance with the Twinsburg City School System named as an additional insured thereon with minimum coverages for the use, occupancy or possession of the subject premises.


As a further condition of the occupancy of the subject premises, the **Lessee** agrees to the following provisions:

- A. Clean up of grounds after use.
- B. To provide a \$2,000,000.00 liability insurance policy and to hold the Twinsburg City School System harmless for the duration of the Festival.
- C. The Twins Days Festival Committee, Inc. Will supervise and maintain supervision during the use of school property.
- D. If any Twinsburg City School District lawns or grounds are damaged, such space will be repaired by the Twinsburg City School District employees with all cost for repair going to the Twins Days Festival Committee, Inc.
- E. The Twins Days Festival will procure any cost associated with janitorial and any school employee that must be present during the Friday night festivities at the High School.

It is further agreed that school personnel shall be permitted to enter upon premises at all times for the purpose of inspection, or any other administrative purpose.


