

students?




















**FEBRUARY GRIT GAMES** 


Celebrated the Winter Olympics & GRIT Day by learning the science of sports to design and engineer a maze and a bobsled.

#### Mrs. Brindley's 4th Grade Class

#### **Language Arts**

Some of our favorites from Language Arts studies so far this year...

\*Reading Groups: Winn Dixie, Shiloh and Sable: Each group reads at their guided reading level. Sometimes we watch the movie to compare the book to the writing.

\*Writing: We wrote stories, learned how to write an opinion piece using an Oreo cookie, multi-paragraph reports and even practiced our cursive! We also do creative writing in our journals.

\*We play a fun game called cherry pie to remember our important spelling and vocabulary words.

\*We learned comprehension strategies to improve our reading and understanding.

#### **Social Studies**

\*We learned about how Ohio land was shaped and the land's resources.

\*We created our own maps to show our understanding. We always find a way to make our learning fun. We read plays to understand our social studies better such as the American Revolution, The War of 1812 and The Northwest Territory.

\*We became employees for the Ohio and Connecticut Land Companies by creating Northwest Territory Land Ads. Please check them out, they are hanging on the wall in the stairwell.

\*We even read Danger Along the Ohio, about a family leaving their home in the east to come to Ohio for a new and better life in the late 1700s and early 1800s.

\*Right now we are researching famous Ohio figures or events to create a research project.

#### **Ohio Salt Dough Maps**

\*We learned how the glaciers shaped the land of Ohio.

\*We also learned about Ohio's landform and economic regions. Ohio is very rich in resources.

\*We created Ohio Salt Dough maps to show the landform regions, natural resources, agriculture, manufacturing, mining, and forestry.

\*We used paint for the landforms, beads to show economic regions (manufacturing, agriculture, mining, forestry), and glitter glue to show the rivers formed from the glacier.

\*We learned about the rivers in Ohio were created or changed by glaciers during the last Ice Age.

#### **Iditarod**

This year we studied the Iditarod:

\*Iditaread: we each read 998 minutes just like the mushers raced 998 miles from Anchorage to Nome.

\*We each picked a musher to follow and check their stats each day.

\*We completed a scavenger hunt. Do you know how many dogs you can have on a team and how many you need to finish?

\*We learned that the race started in honor of Balto, the dog that carried the life-saving serum to Nome in 1925. Can you name the disease that was causing the epidemic?

\*Did you know that the children of Cleveland actually raised money to bring Balto to the Cleveland History Museum?


#### **Guided Reading**

In guided reading, we get to read with different groups, share and discuss our books and grow as readers.


#### **40 Book Challenge**
