#### MEDINA COUNTY RECEIVING RECORD

In a week 2 win (Aug. 31), Wadsworth WR Carson Risher set a Medina County receiving record for yards receiving in a single game. Risher totalled 266 yards receiving in the Grizzlies 37-31 come-from-behind victory over the Wooster Generals.

#### **GRIZZLIES STILL CELEBRATING MR. FOOTBALL**

2018 Wadsworth graduate, Joey Baughman, will forever be considered an Ohio football legend. The quarterback's jawdropping accomplishments in the 2017 season were impossible to ignore and in November of last year he was named Mr. Football as the state's top player.

Previous winners include NFL players Mitchell Trubisky (Mentor, 2012), Delone Carter (Copley, 2005), Tyrell Sutton (Archbishop Hoban, 2004), Maurice Clarett (Warren Harding, 2001), Tony Fisher (Euclid, 1997), Andy Katzenmoyer (Westerville South, 1995), Charles Woodson (Fremont Ross, 1995), Curtis Enis (Mississinawa Valley, 1993), Mark Edwards (Norwood, 1992), Bobby Hoying (St. Henry, 1990) and Robert Smith (Euclid, 1989, '90).

Baughman led Wadsworth to its first undefeated regular season since 1996 and fifth overall . The Grizzlies also won their first Suburban League title since 2009 — they dominated seven SL National Conference opponents by an average of 28 points — and broke Medina County records for points (589) and scoring average (49.1).

The 6-foot-1, 192-pound Baughman ended the season with 3,060 yards passing, 1,533 yards rushing and 56 total touchdowns (36 passing, 20 rushing) despite Wadsworth playing seven games with a running clock in the second half.

Baughman passed on a wrestling scholarship to the University of Virgina, instead electing to play quarterback for Elon University, an on-the-rise Football Championship Subdivision school in North Carolina.



Twinsburg coach Mike Bell has always been a strong believer in building a program and not just simply a football team that competes on Friday night.

Part of that is the involvement of those outside of the players and coaches, including the administration, the community and perhaps most importantly, the football parents.

Bell said the Tigers are extremely lucky to have the support of The Gridiron Club at Twinsburg and he doesn't take it for granted.

"It starts with our administration doing a great job getting our young men the equipment and necessities for the game, but when you think about all the extras to make us a first-class program that is where the Gridiron Club comes in and really helps us," Bell said.

"There are a million ways for parents to get involved and I always encourage parents to get involved and do what they can because it doesn't last forever at the high school level obviously. The years go fast."

The Gridiron Club is an organization of football parents in grades 7 through 12. There is no fee to join and all members of the community are welcome to attend meetings. The Club meets the second Monday of the month at Twinsburg High School. Meetings begin at 6:00 p.m. All of the fundraising is run through Twinsburg Athletic Boosters.

The Gridiron Club raises funds to help support the team off the turf. From purchasing a new sound system for the locker room to feeding the boys on Friday nights and scrimmages, purchasing football gear such as t-shirts and cinch bags, senior gifts and hosting the end of year banquet. These events are important in developing a sense of unity and pride in the program.

### THIS DATE IN HISTORY

**OCTOBER 12, 1989:** The Herschel Walker trade was the largest player trade in the history of the National Football League. This deal, on October 12, 1989, centered around sending running back Herschel Walker from the Dallas Cowboys to the Minnesota Vikings. Including Walker and a transaction involving the San Diego Chargers, the trade eventually involved 18 players and draft picks.

At the time of the deal, the Cowboys were one of the worst teams in the league (the team finished the 1989 season with its worst post-merger record, 1-15), trading away their best player, while the Vikings believed that Walker was the missing piece they needed to make a Super Bowl run. Thus, Minnesota originally felt that they got the better end of the deal. Instead, the Cowboys used the draft picks acquired in this trade to get the players they needed to help them win three Super Bowls in the 1990s, including Emmitt Smith, Russell Maryland, Alonzo Highsmith, and Darren Woodson.

Meanwhile, the Vikings did not make a Super Bowl appearance with Walker. The ultimate irony to this trade is that the Cowboys picked Walker back up during the Free Agency period in 1996 and he would finish out his career in 1997 with the Cowboys.
