Meeting Minutes

In Attendance: Mark Curtis, Rob Felber, Kathi Powers, Matt Strickland, John Sommers

CALL MEETING TO ORDER: The meeting was called to order at 4:34 p.m.

Minutes from the February 9, 2023 meeting were approved.

DISCUSSION ITEMS

Energy Conservation Project Update:

- 99% of projects included in this program are complete.
- \$195,000 savings are projected to be seen each year. All buildings except THS are meeting their numbers.

Safety & Security Grant Funding:

- Funds from the initial grant have been completely expended on the purchase of radios and cameras.
- Eligible for a second Safety Grant from the State of Ohio for up to \$100,000.
- Metal detectors/wands would be the highest priority.
- Have seen a demonstration of EVOLVE technology (metal detector) from RedShift. Has proven to be 100% accurate for detection of assault weapons. Will not detect knives.
- Metal detectors would slow down student entrance to the buildings. Wands could be used randomly. Standing metal detectors are not as welcoming. Wands are mobile and more acceptable.

Summer Projects, 2023:

- Roofing needs of District buildings total \$125,000.
- District HVAC needs total \$250,000.
- Immediate paving needs total approximately \$1.4 million THS (drives and lots) RBC (staff and rear parking lot) Wilcox (staff parking, north drive).

Online Payment Options:

- EZ Pay no longer exists.
- Will switch over to PaySchool for school fees and My School Bucks for food service/school lunch payments. Transition will be completed over summer break.

Ohio Facilities Construction Commission (OFCC)/Expedited Local Partnership Programs (ELPP):

• The Expedited Local Partnership Program (ELPP) permits school districts that are over two years away from eligibility for state assistance under the Classroom Facilities Assistance Program

(CFAP) to receive a district-wide assessment and master facility plan from the Ohio Facilities Construction Commission (OFCC). There is no financial risk involved with the partnership.

• Matt Strickland will present to the entire Board at an upcoming work session.

Rentals:

- City of Twinsburg is only charged for extra labor time over regularly scheduled hours for the Community Theatre's use of the facilities.
- TCSD is charged for Sewer Service, road salt, SRO officers, EMS for football games
- Purchase orders have been opened every year for Council Chambers Network Recording but invoices have not been received
- Borrowing of City of Twinsburg equipment is very minimal.
- Cost for the Cities of Twinsburg and Reminderville to use TCSD buses over the summer has jumped significantly mostly wages and fuel costs.
