- Three (3) On-Campus ninth grade students;
- Four (4) On-Campus tenth grade students;
- Four (4) On-Campus eleventh grade students;
- Two (2) On-Campus twelfth grade students;
- One (1) classified staff member assigned to Wilcox Primary School;
- Five (5) certificated staff members assigned to George G. Dodge Intermediate School;
- One (1) certificated staff member assigned to RB Chamberlin Middle School;
- One (1) classified staff member assigned to RB Chamberlin Middle School;
- One (1) contracted services staff member assigned to RB Chamberlin Middle School and Twinsburg High School;
- One (1) classified staff member of our District Technology Department; and
- Three (3) classified staff members of our Transportation Department

Tomorrow begins our two-week Remote Teaching & Learning period. We realize that pivoting to a virtual platform is a hardship for some of our families and we apologize for the inconvenience this decision may cause. However, given the fact that over the past three weeks, over three hundred (300) members of our Tiger family have tested positive for COVID-19, we believe pivoting to remote teaching and learning is the best way to stop the surge and to protect our students, our staff members, and their families.
