Dear Twinsburg Schools Family:

Today, I reported the following positive cases to Summit County health officials:

- One (1) On-Campus 6th grade student;
- One (1) Virtual Academy 9th grade student; and
- One (1) certificated member of our Bissell staff who is assigned to the campus of Twinsburg High School.

Our District continues to work hard at maintaining the healthiest learning environment possible and we need everyone's help to do so. In the event that a member of a family is being tested for COVID-19, we respectfully request that the children in that family stay home until test results are known. In the event that a positive test result occurs, the children should remain at home until the family is provided further direction from County health officials regarding a quarantine period.

Each of our schools has a Quarantine Support Teacher. The primary role of the Quarantine Support Teacher is to virtually support students with their instruction while they are quarantined from school:

Wilcox Primary School: Mrs. Anne Larsen
Samuel Bissell Elementary School: Mrs. Melissa Cogan
George G. Dodge Intermediate School: Ms. Eugenia Green
RB Chamberlin Middle School: Mr. Robert Smaltz
Twinsburg High School: Ms. Christina Pistone

When the school district is made aware of a positive test result or of a quarantine situation, building principals connect our Quarantine Support Teachers with the students involved in these situations. The Quarantine Support Teachers work closely with our classroom teachers to ensure that quarantined students stay on track with the rest of the students in their class. I appreciate everyone's focus on providing the supports our students need to remain successful, even when they cannot be in class because of a quarantine.

Please be certain to remind your children and each other to practice the COVID-19 safety protocols of wearing a mask, keeping socially distanced from others, and frequently sanitizing hands and/or frequently washing them with soap and water.
