Dear Twinsburg Schools Family:

Today I reported the following COVID-positive cases to Summit County Public Health officials:

- One (1) On-Campus third grade student;
- One (1) certificated staff member at Twinsburg High School; and
- One (1) classified staff member from our Transportation Department

This afternoon, at the end of the school day at Twinsburg High School, a male student was overheard making a verbal threat against the school while he was in the parking lot. An adult who overheard the threat contacted the Twinsburg Police Department. The student was identified through a cell phone photograph taken by the adult. The Twinsburg Police Department quickly addressed this situation. Twinsburg High School staff and students were never in any danger. School consequences will be determined tomorrow. In the meantime, I am sending this information to remind everyone that we take threats against our students, staff members, and school property very seriously. Disciplinary consequences are defined in our Student Handbooks and may include suspension, expulsion, and/or referral to the Twinsburg Police Department for further action. We appreciate the expeditious response from the Twinsburg Police Department.
