Although the Ohio Department of Health and the Summit County Public Health Department have lessened restrictions as related to COVID-19, our students and staff members continue to test positive for this virus. I am not sending this information to alarm you, however, I want to let you know that our District has had over ninety (90) positive cases since the school year began. This weekend, I reported COVID-clusters, as required by the ODH and SCPH. A COVID-cluster is determined when three or more individuals from the same classroom, sports team or other group test positive.
