Get Your Tiger License Plate!

A reminder that you can show your Tiger Pride and purchase a Tiger logo license plate for your vehicle.

Here are the instructions provided by the Ohio Bureau of Motor Vehicles:

"Visit your local deputy registrar and request the logo license plate. This transaction can be a first time (new), exchange, or exchange/renewal. The order will be processed and the plate usually takes approximate 14 – 21 business days to receive via USPS. You may also go to our www.oplates.com and order from the website to exchange or renew/exchange to the logo plate. The transaction will be processed and the mail time is approximately the same."

A portion of the sales for our Tiger logo license plates will be returned to the District and have been earmarked for our Positive Behavior Intervention Supports (PBIS) initiatives.
