# Wilcox & Bissell Parent Meeting Regarding Child Sexual Abuse Prevention Instruction

Ohio's 134th General Assembly enacted Senate Bill 288 which requires schools to provide developmentally appropriate instruction in child sexual abuse prevention to students in grades K through 6. Additional information is available by searching "Senate House Bill 288" on www.education.ohio.gov.

This April, students at Wilcox Primary School and Samuel Bissell Elementary School will be offered the program, Fight Child Abuse, <u>www.fightchildabuse.org</u>. This program helps in the prevention of abuse and teaches children the "Protect Yourself Rules". The "Protect Yourself Rules" include:

- \* Stranger Safety
  - \* Hitting is Wrong
- \* Safe/Unsafe Touch
  \* Tell a Grown-Up
- \* Shout, Run, Tell

\* It Doesn't Matter Who It Is

This program will be taught in Wilcox and Bissell classrooms by a trained Beech Brook facilitator. Beech Brook will also provide parents/caregivers with information about the program at a parent meeting. Parents will receive information about the program, facts related to child sexual abuse, and prevention tips.

The parent meeting for our Wilcox and Bissell parents is scheduled for Monday, March 18, 2024. Two (2) meetings are being offered, one at 6:00 p.m. and the other at 7:00 p.m. Please select the meeting time that is more convenient for you. The meeting will be held in the Large Group Instruction Room (LGI) at Twinsburg High School.

Students in grades 4 - 6 will be instructed later this Spring with a similar program offered by Townhall. Information to follow...
