#### **Major GOALS**

One of our Tiger parents, Mrs. Raeshonda Ferrell, has been working to develop a program called Major Goals and Objectives for Academic Liberty and Success (Major G.O.A.L.S.). Major G.O.A.L.S. is a community-based Nonprofit 501(c)(3) Organization aimed at providing educational services, creating support networks, and establishing academic resources for African American and economically disadvantaged families. The purpose of the organization is to turn the tide on academic underachievement of youth ages 5-19. The mission of Major G.O.A.L.S. is to improve academic outcomes, personal achievement, and overall well-being. The program's three primary goals are to increase cumulative GPA, increase attendance, and decrease disciplinary incidents. In addition to the program's three primary goals, each participant creates quarterly goals and when met are rewarded with various incentives and prizes.

The Major G.O.A.L.S. program offers free weekly academic tutoring on Tuesdays at Kent State University and Saturdays at Faith United Methodist Church. The program also has monthly family workshops focusing on the dimensions of wellness and personal development. These workshops are held at the Twinsburg Public Library.
