Additionally, I am sending today's correspondence with important information about Friday, October 22, 2021. As you may know, our TCSD staff members received the COVID-19 vaccination on our campuses last school year. Because of their direct care of students, they are now eligible to receive the Pfizer Booster. Thanks to our partners at Discount Drug Mart, our staff members will receive the Pfizer Booster, again on our campuses, on Friday, October 22nd. It is expected that a majority of our staff members will elect to receive this vaccination. Because some individuals who receive the Pfizer vaccine experience side effects within hours of the administration of the vaccine, our Board of Education has authorized Friday, October 22nd as a Remote Teaching & Learning Day. This means that our students will learn remotely from home on Friday, October 22nd as our teachers teach from our campuses. This will be a synchronous learning day, meaning real-time interaction between teachers and students for the duration of the school day using Chromebooks and the Google classroom.
