

Canva for Education

- 1. Students must have a signed COPPA form giving consent, on file. The COPPA form is a form that is a part of their returning or new student registration through Infosnap.
- Teachers sign up for free Canva for Education (Canva for Education includes free premium features) by going to https://www.canva.com/education/ and clicking on Sign Up



- 3. According to the Privacy Policy and Terms of Use, students under 18 can not use Canva without consent from an authorized adult (e.g., a teacher or parent) and therefore will need to be invited by the teacher before creating an account and joining a class.
- 4. Teachers can have students join a class by using the invite code or the invitation link.
- 5. Teachers of students in grades PK-10 can not choose the option Invite via Google Classroom or invite via email, as an invite email is sent to the student's email and outside email is blocked for students. (see screenshot below). Invite via share link to classroom (picture 1) or Invite via code (see picture 2) will work
- 6. Have students sign in using their school Google credentials
