The Home Weatherization Assistance Program (HWAP) assists income qualified individuals to lower their energy usage.

HWAP may be able to provide the following services to income qualified Summit County residents:

**NEW ENERGY EFFICIENT FURNACE**  
**NEW HOT WATER TANK**  
**INSULATION**  
**NEW REFRIGERATOR**  
**NEW FREEZER**  
**LED LIGHT BULBS**

An inspection is completed on each home to determine what services are needed. HWAP is not an emergency service, and applications are considered in the order in which they are approved.

***Services are completed at NO COST to the applicant.***
