Twinsburg Board of Education Passes Resolutions for May Bond Levy

On Wednesday, January 22, 2025, the Twinsburg Board of Education passed the second of two (2) resolutions required to place a Bond levy on the May 6, 2025 ballot. This \$97,000,000. Bond levy will be a 3.84 mill request for a period of 36 years at an interest rate of 5%. The millage rate equates to an annual cost of \$135.00 per \$100,000 of appraised property value as designated by Summit County.

This Bond levy will support the construction of a new PK-6 elementary school, which will replace Wilcox Primary School, Samuel Bissell Elementary School, and George G. Dodge Intermediate School along with the renovation of the District's athletic fields. This modified version of the District's *Tiger Legacy Project* is in response to the feedback we received from our community members during the last Bond levy effort which was a \$107,000,000. effort at 4.27 mills.

More details about our modified *Tiger Legacy Project* will be announced at a *Community Conversation about the Tiger Legacy Project* in February. Stay tuned for details about this exciting project which will benefit our students and our community!

A Perfect Day for a Sled Ride!


