A RESOLUTION DETERMINING TO PROCEED WITH THE SUBMISSION TO THE ELECTORS OF THE SCHOOL DISTRICT OF THE QUESTION OF RENEWING ALL OF AN EXISTING TAX LEVY PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 5705.194 TO 5705.197 OF THE REVISED CODE.

WHEREAS, at an election on November 8, 2005, the electors of the School District approved the renewal of an existing tax in excess of the ten-mill limitation in order to raise the amount of \$5,184,569 each calendar year for a period of five years for the purpose of providing for the emergency requirements of the School District, the last collection of which will occur in calendar year 2011; and

WHEREAS, on June 23, 2010, this Board adopted Resolution No. 10-192 declaring it necessary to submit to the electors of the School District the question of renewing all of that tax levy in excess of the tenmill limitation, as described below, a copy of which resolution was certified to the Summit County Fiscal Officer; and

WHEREAS, on June 29, 2010, the Summit County Fiscal Officer certified that the total current tax valuation of the School District is \$849,884,310 and the estimated annual tax levy required throughout the life of the proposed levy to produce the annual amount of \$5,184,569 as set forth in that resolution, calculated in the manner provided by Section 5705.195 of the Revised Code, is 5.03 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to 50.3 cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Education of Twinsburg City School District, County of Summit, Ohio, that:

- Section 1. <u>Determination to Proceed.</u> This Board hereby determines to proceed with the submission to the electors at an election to be held on November 2, 2010, of the question of renewing all of an existing tax levy in excess of the ten-mill limitation for a period of 10 years (commencing with a levy on the tax list and duplicate for the year 2011 to be first distributed to this Board in calendar year 2012) in order to raise the amount of \$5,184,569 each year for the purpose of providing for the emergency requirements of the School District, at the annual tax rate as is necessary to raise that amount, which rate is currently estimated by the Summit County Fiscal Officer to be 5.03 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to 50.3 cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation.
- Section 2. <u>Certification and Delivery of Materials to Board of Elections</u>. The Treasurer is authorized and directed to certify to the Summit County Board of Elections copies of this Resolution, and the resolution and the related certificate of the Summit County Fiscal Officer referred to in the preambles hereto, before the close of business on Wednesday, August 4, 2010. This Board hereby requests that the Board of Elections give notice, prepare the ballots, and make other necessary arrangements for the submission of this question to the electors of the School District, all in accordance with law.
- Section 3. <u>Compliance with Open Meeting Requirements</u>. This Board finds and determines that all formal actions of this Board and of any of its committees concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken, and that all deliberations of this Board and of any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were held, in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.
- Section 4. <u>Captions and Headings</u>. The captions and headings in this Resolution are solely for convenience of reference and in no way define, limit or describe the scope or intent of any Sections, subsections, paragraphs, subparagraphs or clauses hereof.
- Section 5. <u>Effective Date</u>. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and immediately upon its adoption.
