#### 1 Window Page

### **Page Layout:**

The main content area (outlined with orange box) allows for either 1 (Figure A) or 2 (Figure B) Content Windows. Content Windows are the content managed columns on each page of the website.

In order to place content on a page, such as text, links, documents or images, Page Components must be added and populated within the Content Windows.

#### Terms to know:

Content Managed refers to anything on the website in which a user is able to edit, update, or delete within the Content Management System.

Page Components are blocks of content stacked upon one another within Content Windows 1 & 2.

Content Windows are the columns that make up a page. Each page will always have a left navigation, which is made up of Touts and/or the Dynamic Navigation.

**Touts** are located in the leftmost column and are custom made graphical buttons which are placed on the site based on the approved design. Touts are content managed and may be rearranged, added, or deleted at any time.

Dynamic Navigation, located in the leftmost column, is where text based links are automatically generated by the system upon page creation. These links/pages may be visible, hidden, or moved at any time.






#### WINDOW 2:

The second window or column functions just like Window 1. This area is ideal for links, files and events.
