The PAWS on Child Hunger program provides weekend food assistance for Wilcox Primary School, Samuel Bissell Elementary School, George D. Dodge Intermediate School and RB Chamberlin Middle School children who qualify.

Students receive a bag of nutritious, kid-friendly food items to take home on Friday afternoons during the school year. The bags are placed discreetly in the students' backpacks or lockers before they leave for the weekend.

Students qualify if they are on the free or reduced school lunch program. The program is totally voluntary and totally anonymous.
