**16-124 Charter School Resolution**

Mr. Curtis moved and Mrs. Turle-Waldron seconded that the Twinsburg Board of Education approves the following resolution to invoice the Ohio Department of Education for charter school deductions from state funding;

**WHEREAS**, it is the statutory duty of the Twinsburg City School District Board of Education to deliver the educational programs and services to the school children of the Twinsburg City School District; and

**WHEREAS**, the members of the Board are elected by the Twinsburg school community to ensure an effective, efficient, vibrant and productive system; and

**WHEREAS**, the elected board of education is responsible to the community including taxpayers, parents and other patrons, as well as the state; and

**WHEREAS**, the charter school industry now extracts approximately one billion dollars (\$1,000,000,000) annually from public school districts across the State of Ohio; and

**WHEREAS**, school district boards of education have no control of students, financing, educational programming and student outcomes who enroll in charter schools; and

**WHEREAS**, charter schools as a group in Ohio demonstrate low academic performance compared to traditional public schools; and

**WHEREAS**, the Twinsburg City School District has lost a total of \$2,706,747 in state AND local funding to charter schools as of February 29, 2016; and

**WHEREAS**, this deduction has reduced programs and services to Twinsburg City School District students; and

**WHEREAS**, the Twinsburg City School District Board of Education has a fiduciary responsibility to the students and taxpayers of the District;

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**BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED this 16<sup>th</sup> day of March 2016** that the Board of Education directs the Treasurer of the District to invoice the Ohio Department of Education (State of Ohio) for all the funds extracted from the Twinsburg City School District for charter school students.
