**Reopening Plan Discussion:**

On August 10, 2020, Summit County Public Health Department (SCPH) released a paper entitled "Recommendations for Summit County K-12 School Reopening" (as attached). The Superintendent and Board Members discussed the precautions Twinsburg City School District (TCSD) has developed regarding cleaning surfaces, sanitization with electrostatic sprayers and safety protocols. TCSD's hybrid model and protocols are supported by SCPH recommendations. Comments were made that generally parents will have to make choices in the best interest of their children and family. Additionally, all parties will need to remain flexible, take precautions and be prepared for making sacrifices. Twinsburg CSD, the Teachers, the Support Staff (unions) have expended a huge amount of effort and work as TCSD prepares for the new school year.
