

Padlet Requirements for Free Version of Padlet*:

1. Students should have a signed COPPA form on file giving consent
2. Teacher should not allow students to create accounts to create Padlets for the following reasons:
 - There isn't a way to control the ability of students making a Padlet public which could lead to students giving personal information to the general public.
 - There isn't a way for teachers to monitor posts to a student created Padlet
 - The teacher has no control over the student created Padlet account
 - Padlet is not currently directed to children according to the Terms of Service <https://padlet.com/about/terms>
3. Teachers can create Padlets, make them private, password protected or secret and invite the students to participate. Students won't need a Padlet account to contribute to the teacher's Padlet
4. Teachers can also monitor comments made by students on the teacher created Padlet
