







Goal #1: Complete Financial Plan to maintain fiscal stability through FY23 which shall include strategies for passing \$5 million renewal levy in November 2020.


Goal #2: TCSD will research and develop intervention and diversion programs to address the needs of students dealing with substance abuse.

Action Step for 2020-2021:

This will be evidenced by High Quality Professional Development and the ongoing implementation of Blended Learning strategies in both oncampus and virtual classrooms.

Action Steps for 2020-2021:

TCSD will develop and administer a survey to measure the degree to which the communication efforts align with the District Comprehensive Communication Plan.

TCSD will update the Master Facilities Plan to address COVID-19 and HVAC considerations and document the recommendations which will be used to guide short and long term projects.

TCSD will partner with a marketing consultant to define a plan which engages stakeholders to gather additional feedback and determine the direction of the Conceptual Legacy Project.
