# THS 2018 Graduates

## mark the time of their lives!

winsburg High School celebrated the 321 members of its 2018 graduating class at Commencement held at E.J. Thomas Performing Arts Hall in Akron on Tuesday,

May 22, 2018. Family members, friends, teachers, and staff came together with the Twinsburg High School Class of 2018 to share in the excitement and to recognize the graduates' significant accomplishments.

In her last remarks to a graduating class at Twinsburg High School, retiring principal Mrs. Louise Teringo selected the song "(I've Had The) Time of My Life" from the 1987 film "Dirty Dancing" to engage the students and audience. The tradition of selecting a song to represent the graduating class has been a tradition of Teringo's, who is retiring after serving as the school's principal since 2009. In talking about the song, she referenced the famous scene where the character of "Baby" is lifted during the song.

"The highlight of the song is the 'lift'," said Teringo. "If you take out the 'lift' the song is not memorable."

She spoke to the Class of 2018 about the number of highlights and memorable moments that lifted them along their journey through Twinsburg High School.

"Seniors, these years have been fun, and someone was always nearby ready to celebrate that 'lift' with you."

Teringo highlighted those 'lifts', including athletic successes and the successes of the band, orchestra and show choir. But what she was most proud to highlight was the academic reputation of Twinsburg High School that continues to flourish.

"Let's celebrate this 'lift' together," Teringo implored, noting that Twinsburg High School was ranked in the Top 15 high schools in Northeast Ohio and 42nd in the entire state by the U.S. News and World Report in May 2018.

That academic success could be seen in the recognition of the THS Class of 2018 -'Top Ten Students', who joined in the procession taking their seats on stage along

with members of the Twinsburg Board of Education, Twinsburg City School District Administration, Twinsburg High School Principal and Assistant Principals, Twinsburg High School Guidance Department Staff, and building principals and assistant principals from Wilcox Primary, Samuel Bissell Elementary, George G. Dodge Intermediate, and R.B. Chamberlin Middle School. The graduates entered E.J. Thomas Hall to the traditional processional of "Pomp and Circumstance, No. 1," by Elgar played by the Twinsburg High School Concert Band, under the direction of Mr. Ryan Bonitz.

THS Senior Class Vice-President Jasleen Gill welcomed all in attendance. She emphasized the importance of reflection and asked the audience for a moment of silence and reflection to remember those who could not be in attendance that evening. Lyric Albert, THS Senior Class Treasurer, introduced honored guests, including THS teachers and district administrators, counselors, and board of education members.

Following introductions, seniors Hannah Chauvin and Hannah Whitley each displayed their musical talents. Both powerful vocalists, Chauvin sang "Proud" while also performing on the piano, while Whitley sang the song "Home".

Twinsburg City School District Superintendent Kathryn Powers spoke to the Class of 2018 about the passing of time. She took the class on a journey of highlights from their educational experiences, mentioning their fifth-grade field trip to Michigan and their eighth-grade trip to Washington, D.C.

"In your parents' minds-eye they see you as you were on your first day of Kindergarten. That very special day as you boarded the school bus for the first time, with a backpack bigger than you and your parents standing proudly, waving at you through the bus window videotaping every second."

Powers talked about the graduation as another moment and another turning point in their lives and issued a challenge to the Class of 2018.

"I challenge you to not just live in the moment, but to look for those special moments which will shape you for your lifetime. Live well, Class of 2018! And, remember, once a Tiger always a Tiger. We are very proud of you!"

The presentation of the "Top Ten Students" followed with Twinsburg High School Assistant Principal Alex Popovich providing the introductions. The students were recognized for their exemplary academic accomplishments, extra-curricular activities, athletic achievements, community involvement, special areas of interest, and the college or university which they would be attending. Jason Stahlman was recognized as the THS Class of 2018 Valedictorian. Stahlman, who plans to major in finance at the University of Michigan's Ross School of Business, was a member of the THS baseball and soccer programs for four years, serving as a captain in soccer his senior year. He also was a member of the National Honor Society and was the founder and president of the THS Economics Club.

Soumil Jain was recognized as the THS Class of 2018 Salutatorian. Jain plans to focus on



data science and/or enter the pre-med program at the University of California-Berkeley. He was a four-year member of the tennis team, academic challenge team and foreign language club at THS. He also was the founder and president of the THS Computer Club.

Others recognized as the "Top Ten Students" included Lalithaamrutha Yarlagadda (Economics/Political Science, Case Western University), Nithya Kasibhatla (Chemistry/English, University of Pittsburgh), Nathan Moeliono (Computer Engineering, Virginia Tech University), Ethan Bernhard (Finance, University of Notre Dame), Justin Clement (Business Economics, College of Wooster), Jared Bray (Actuarial Science/Economics, University of Texas at Dallas), Aaryan Singh (Aerospace Engineering, Purdue University), and Joseph Rzeszut (Mathematics, John Carroll University).

THS Class Secretary, Cassidy Liotta, shared special recognition, national awards, and noted the 26,269 hours of community service provided by the Class of 2018, including more than 1,500 hours performed by just one senior.

Prior to the presentation of graduates, the audience rose to give Principal Teringo a standing ovation in recognition of her years of service to the school district. Teringo's assistant principals presented her with flowers and she once again thanked everyone. She concluded with special recognition of retiring THS staff members, thanking them for their years of service. Teringo then presented the Class of 2018 as having met or exceeded the requirements set forth by the State of Ohio and the Twinsburg Board of Education for graduation. The diplomas were presented by Matthew Cellura, Twinsburg Board of Education

President, Robert Felber, Twinsburg Board of Education Vice President, Mark Curtis, Member, Tina Davis, Member, Angela DeFabio, Member, Kathryn Powers, Superintendent, and Louise Teringo, THS Principal.

THS Class of 2018 Class President Zachary Dobrski then led the class in the traditional "Turning of the Tassel Ceremony". The graduates eagerly moved their tassels from right to left, signifying that they were now officially graduates and alumni of the Twinsburg City School District. The journey as Twinsburg High School students officially concluded, but as Teringo mentioned to the class during her remarks, "Hopefully, you'll remember fondly the time of your life."
