# **COVID Concerns On the Rise**

The Twinsburg City School District is beginning to see an increase in COVID cases, so I want to take this opportunity to update you regarding the CDC Guidelines, which align to the guidelines supported by the Summit County Public Health Department as well as the Ohio Department of Health. Attached is a user-friendly graphic from the CDC that our District Nurse Kati Foster thought might be helpful. Additionally, here are a few reminders:

- COVID is considered a *respiratory virus* stay home with symptoms and fever.
- Students and staff can return when afebrile (fever free) for 24 hours and symptoms improve.
- Individuals who test positive for COVID are encouraged to wear a mask upon returning to school, up to day 10 after testing positive.
