















TCSD will update the Master Facilities Plan to address COVID 19 and HVAC considerations and document the recommendations which will be used to guide short and long term projects.

# TWINSBURG CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS REGARDING THE DISTRICT'S FINANCIAL LANDSCAPE MAY, 2021

#### THE \$5 Million RENEWAL LEVY

- What can you tell me about this levy?
  - This is a \$5 million Renewal Levy for the day-to-day expenses of the district. It is NOT a new tax. This type of levy, called an Emergency Levy is submitted to the electorate as a fixed dollar amount for a period of one (1) to ten (10) years. The mills are adjusted each year of the levy to account for changes in the tax duplicate in order to keep the school income constant for the term of the levy. After the voted period lapses, the levy expires unless reapproved by a vote of the electorate.
- 2. Is this a continuing levy?
  - No. It is a Renewal Levy for a period of ten (10) years.
- 3. Will I see this levy on my tax bill?
  - This is a Renewal Levy and is NOT a new tax. This levy was originally approved May 8, 2001.
