I. TONE

- 5- Full, rich, and characteristic of the tone quality in all ranges
- 4- Characteristic in most ranges, but occasionally inconsistencies in some passages
- 3- Developing characteristic tone quality
- 2- Inconsistent in basic tone production
- 1- Significant improvement needed in basic tone production

II. MELODIC ACCURACY

- 5- Accurate throughout, in all ranges/positions
- 4- Accurate, but isolated notes in need of adjustment in some ranges/positions
- 3- Developing melodic accuracy; some inaccuracies in some ranges/positions
- 2- Many incorrect notes substantially detract from the overall performance
- 1- Significant number of incorrect notes, entire passages performed incorrectly

III. RHYTHMIC ACCURACY

- 5- Accurate rhythms throughout, tempo consistent
- 4- A few incorrect rhythmic figures, tempo inconsistent
- 3- Developing rhythmic accuracy; some incorrect rhythmic figures, tempo mostly consistent
- 2- Many incorrect rhythmic figures detracting from overall performance, tempo somewhat inconsistent
- 1- Significant rhythmic errors, whole sections incorrectly performed, inconsistent tempo (e.g., rushing, dragging)

IV. INTONATION

- 5- Accurate throughout all ranges/positions
- 4- Accurate, with occasional intonation issues on isolated pitches which student tries to adjust
- 3- Developing intonation; mostly accurate, but some out of tune notes. Attempts to adjust to correct pitch.
- 2- Exhibits basic sense of intonation, but has significant problems. Makes little or no apparent attempt to adjust to correct pitch.
- 1- Significant intonation issues, makes no apparent attempt to adjust to correct pitch

V. MUSICIANSHIP

- 5- Consistently performs all expressive markings, articulations, dynamics, and bowings (where applicable)
- 4- Performs almost all expressive markings, articulations, dynamics, and bowings (where applicable)
- 3- Performs most expressive markings, articulations, dynamics, and bowings (where applicable)
- 2- Performs few of the expressive markings, articulations, dynamics, and bowings (where applicable)
- 1- Ignores expressive markings, articulations, dynamics, and bowings (where applicable)
