The goal of this club is to get our KG—3rd grade students started in a “ACTIVE LIFESTYLE” by walking or jogging on a designated track at recess time. Student will be able to participate at “**NO CHARGE**” and will receive mileage rewards as they reach set milestones. The first reward given at 10 miles is a chain necklace and a colored foot charm. Students would subsequently earn another foot charm (every 10 miles) up through mile 50, when they receive a 50 charm.
