

Our Lady Tigers finished the game on a 20-5 run, highlighted by back to back 3 pointers for MacKenzie Sweeney to give Twinsburg the 50-48 victory! On Wednesday night, perennial powerhouse Stow-Munroe Falls came to Twinsburg, and in a must-win situation, the Lady Tigers prevailed 44-34! Capping off their week, our Lady Tigers traveled to Wadsworth on Saturday, needing to win to clinch a share of the Suburban League Championship. Behind an amazing defensive effort, Twinsburg defeated Wadsworth 30-25, giving our Lady Tigers at least a share of the Suburban League Championship for the first time since 2017!

Congratulations to Head Coach Genos, Assistant Coach Sweeney, Assistant Coach Lemieux, and to all of our Lady Tigers on a 13-5 overall record to date, an 11-2 Suburban League record to date, and a Suburban League Championship!
