07-296 Executive Session

Mrs. Cain-Criswell moved and Mr. Shebeck seconded that the Twinsburg Board of Education enter into Executive Session at approximately 6:02 p.m. for the purpose of discussing:

07-300 Approve Tax-Deferred Deductions

That the Twinsburg Board of Education approves the attached Resolution for Adoption of a Tax-Deferred Payroll Deduction Plan, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent

Whereas Internal Revenue Code Section (414)(h)(2) permits employers "pickup" of the employee portion of contributions to a retirement plan, thereby resulting in a tax deferral of employee contributions; and

Whereas under the <u>State Teachers Retirement System of Ohio</u> (STRS Ohio) and <u>State Employees</u>
<u>Retirement System of Ohio</u> (SERS Ohio) laws and rules, members may: (1) redeposit contributions previously withdrawn plus interest, and/or (2) purchase eligible credit.

Now therefore be it resolved that in order to permit tax deferral for these additional amounts, any employee who wishes to purchase or restore STRS/SERS Ohio credit by payroll deduction must enter into a binding irrevocable payroll deduction authorization and such employee shall not

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have the option of choosing to receive the amounts directly instead of having them paid by the employer to STRS/SERS Ohio;

Be it further resolved that additional amounts herein specified, through payroll deduction from salary, are designated as being picked up by the employer and paid by the employer in accordance with Internal Revenue Code requirements.

This resolution adopted by Twinsburg City School District shall have an effective date of November 16, 2007.

07-301 Approve Tax-Deferred Changes

As a result of newly released IRS Regulations governing the 403(b) plans the Twinsburg City School District is required to develop and adopt new policies and procedures to comply with the new regulations

Whereas, Board Policy 6520-PAYROLL DEDUCTIONS the Board declares its willingness to purchase or procure tax-sheltered annuities (403b) for its employees who request that such annuities be purchased through payroll deduction. It shall be clearly understood that the Board's only function shall be the deduction and remittance of employee funds.

Whereas, The agent, broker or company must be designated by a number of employees equal to at least one percent (1%) of the Board's full-time employees or at least five (5) employees, whichever is greater (except under no circumstances shall the agent, broker or company need to be designated by more than fifty (50) employees).

Whereas, The Board's function in the 403b relationship is changing.

Therefore be it Resolved, that the Twinsburg City School District declares 403b providers must maintain at a minimum the one percent (1%) of the Board's full-time employees or at least five (5) employees to hold an active payroll deduction. Providers that fall below the minimum as set forth will be removed from Twinsburg City School District's list of 403b providers.
